Papers should not be more than **7500 words**, prepared following the guidelines in the attached Paper Template, and submitted online at **www.ghiejournal.com**.

All papers shall go through peer reviews, and authors will be required to address review comments (if required) prior to paper acceptance and publication in a special issue of the Journal of the Ghana Institution of Engineering (JGhIE).
